# Guidelines Issued by the Ministry of Education in response to COVID-19

**20**<sup>th</sup> March, 2020- to provide mid-day meals in schools or dry rations in lieu of cooked meals, or provide a food security allowance in lieu of mid-day meals to school children, wherein the cost of food grains and cooking cost should be transferred to the beneficiary accounts

### 29 April '20

- States and UTs will continue to provide Mid-day meals even during summer vacations.
- For summer vacations, states and UTs shall ensure implementation of the provisions within seven days of start of summer vacations.
- The dry ration may be pre packed and distributed either door-to-door, or at the schools or at any other convenient places like PDS outlets etc.

### 31 July '20

- States and UTs are advised to decide the items and their quantities to be provided to children as per the entitlements using the per meal cooking cost along with the food grains.
- The state and UTs are advised to take necessary actions to provide the Food Security Allowance comprising of food grains and pulses, oil etc (equivalent to cooking cost) to all the eligible children.

### 21 August '20

 States and UTs ere requested to ensure provision of pulses, oil etc instead of transferring the cooking cost to children / their parent's bank accounts


The NFSA 2013 legally entitles upto

The Mid-ay meal is part of the NFSA



#### **GUJARAT**

The dry ration being distributed at the schools to the parents through vouchers.



#### **ANDHRA PRADESH**

Dry ration to 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> grade+eggs and chikki to children using state resources



Along with dry ration, soaps and sanitizer also being given

#### **ODISHA**

Coupon with unique UDISE ID assigned to the students to get dry ration from the Fair Price Shops.



#### DADRA & NAGAR HAVELI, DAMAN & DIU

Sukhdi-A nutritious sweet made from wheat flour, jaggery and ghee being given along with dry ration.



#### SIKKIM

Dry ration+cooking ingredients distributed till September 2020





#### **JAMMU & KASHMIR**

Around 8.29 lakh children given dry rations and cooking cost in the second phase (June-July)
